REFLECTION

In classrooms across the globe, professors and students are lecturing, reading, discussing and writing about Islamic topics. The courses may be found in the catalogs of the institutions under theology, religion, philosophy, world studies, history, literature, politics, and even culture. They use various methods of study and sources, but it seems they overlook or marginalize authentic primary sources.

Aside from the long-standing and ongoing work of scholars, researchers and students within and without Islam, there is a new current of interest in Islam, a new wave of scholarship, due to some present-day events and situations that can be seen as positive and negative.

One positive movement in Islamic world history that garnered great attention is the revolution of the Iranian people against a despotic ruler, a revolution that included a nearly unanimous popular referendum to choose an Islamic republic over monarchy and was remarkable Islamically in following the duty to forbid the wrong and command the good and politically with a truly democratic vote, involving little bloodshed.

On the negative side, there is the appearance of wolves in sheep's clothing, i.e., Wahhabism, the so-called Islamic state, Taliban, al Qaeda, Boko Haram and related groups, who teach and practice suicide, fratricide, murder, terror, and mayhem in their perverted take on the teachings of Islam. However, aside from a comparative few motivated to join these groups for various reasons, most thinking people look at their activities and are prompted to ask what the Qur'an really says.

In the wake of these events and situations, more scholars and non-scholars than ever have professed and activated a desire to know more about Islam and Muslims, either out of curiosity, or love of knowledge, or their intuition that these groups cannot be following a monotheistic Abrahamic religion, or even to counter or deride Islam. In any case, today's student of Islam has both the benefit as well as the challenge of a plethora of materials including original or at least early texts, missing texts quoted in later works, research collections, translations, commentaries, interpretations and current writings by Muslims and non-Muslims.

Scholarly discussion has revolved around whether to use "aql or naql [reason or revelation]," but a reasonable approach to the divine sources seems to be the most fruitful because it is the revealed word itself that gives the guidance to use divinely placed reason and natural wisdom. Allah (swt) would not have created our "fitra [nature]" with its ability to know and act on that knowing, or provided us the revelation and the words and actions of the prophets, especially the Seal of the prophets and the extension of his presence as it were in his purified family up to the hidden presence of out twelfth imam, peace be on all of them, unless we were to benefit from them as exemplars, teachers, and guides and to put effort into learning and actualizing what was revealed.

The earliest hadiths transmitted by those who would later be called by the names of all the schools of thought in Islam attest to the words and actions of the Messenger of Islam, and of his daughter Fatima, whose martyrdom and birth we mark in these days, and of his vicegerent Ali and all their children (pbut), which place them in the position of offering leadership and guidance. It begs the question then, given the importance of the chain of transmission in evaluating hadith, and that the imams form such an unbroken chain of correct knowledge, leadership, worship, truthfulness, and ethics, not to mention infallibility, why they are not approached as the final word, the truly "primary sources" in any scholarly inquiry or debate or in the striving of any person to live a correct and meaningful life filled with the love of the Sustainer.

Prophet Muhammad, Bibi Fatima, and the twelve Imams (pbut), with their dynamic positive social action, unparalleled knowledge, and singleness of purpose are unwavering, focused, inerrant from the first to the last, and therefore qualified and known as fountains of knowledge, sources of imitation, and guiding companions on the road to the garden, where for them, and hopefully for us, "their greeting will be 'Peace!"
