ZAFREEN JAFFERY

Zafreen Jaffery, Ed.D. works for The Children's Trust in Miami, FL as a research and evaluation analyst for the early childhood development initiative. She is passionate about promoting educational equity and social justice for all children. Originally from Pakistan, she brings years of expertise in research, evaluation, teaching and program management. Dr. Jaffery earned an Ed.D. in educational leadership from Portland State University in 2012.

Her dissertation focused on a dual case study of an urban and a rural school managed by two NGOs in Pakistan for children from low socio-economic background. After graduation, she worked for Education Northwest in Portland, OR, where she produced research briefs and evaluation reports, and provided technical assistance to five states in the Pacific Northwest. Her select project work includes conducting evaluation of the following initiatives: a Technical Assistance Academy for school coaches; a pre-college program at the University of Wisconsin, Madison; and a collective impact initiative funded by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation in South Seattle and South King County.

Her doctorate, as an international student, was supported by a generous non-interest loan from the Anjuman without which she would not have been able to accomplish her dream.
